## What is the Difference between a Wifi Amazon<sup>®</sup> Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speaker and Bluetooth Amazon<sup>®</sup> Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speaker?



### *What is a Wifi Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speaker?*

Wifi Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speakers are currently the most popular type. For Example the Amazon<sup>®</sup> Echo and Amazon<sup>®</sup> Dot are Wifi Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speakers. If it's a Wifi Speaker it means the Alexa<sup>™</sup> voice assistance must be connected to your Wifi network. Once its connected to your wifi network, ask "Alexa" a question. It will use your wifi network to search for your answer. The Alexa<sup>™</sup> voice assistance can't be used if the speaker isn't connected to your Wifi network.



### *What is a Bluetooth Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speaker?*

The other type of Alexa<sup>™</sup> Speakers are Bluetooth and work off of your Mobile Network. Which means you must connect the speaker to your mobile device by Bluetooth. Once it's connected and you activate Alexa<sup>™</sup> through an App, Alexa<sup>™</sup> will use your mobile network to find you an answer. So anywhere you have service you'll be able to use Alexa<sup>™</sup>!

## How do I activate Amazon<sup>®</sup> Alexa<sup>™</sup>? Is it Push-To-Talk or Far Field?



### *HOW DO I ACTIVATE PUSH-TO-TALK?*

- To activate the voice assistant, user will need to press the microphone button.
- Once activated, user can ask Alexa<sup>™</sup> a question.
- User will need to push the button again to ask another command.



### *HOW DO I ACTIVATE FAR FIELD?*

- Devices using Far Field have built-in microphones that are always on and listening for the command word "Alexa<sup>™</sup>".
- Once activated with the verbal command "Alexa<sup>™</sup>", user can begin to ask Alexa<sup>™</sup> a question.
